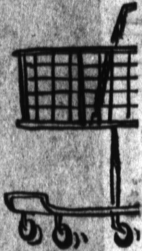

Airman Clark, a graduate of Narbonne High School, is being assigned to Charleston AFB, S.C., for duty. He attended Harbor College.



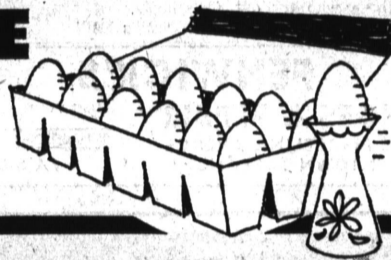
