

Youth to Be Arraigned For Assault, Burglary

A 19-year-old Torrance youth who was shot March 17 by an off-duty Torrance policeman has been ordered to appear in Superior Court on charges of burglary and assault.

Bobby Frederickson, of 703 Sartori Ave., Apt. C, is to be arraigned at 9 a.m. April 19 in Department A of the Southwest Superior Court.

Frederickson appeared before Judge George Perkovich in South Bay Municipal Court last Friday. Bail was set at \$5,000 and Frederickson was remanded to the county jail.

He is accused of burglary and assault with intent to commit rape. Frederickson was shot once by Ron Bryning, a Torrance police officer, while fleeing from an apartment which he is accused of breaking into last March 17.

Bryning, who lives in the neighborhood, was attacked by the screams of Sara Beth Mitchell, 24, of 718 Amapola Ave.
