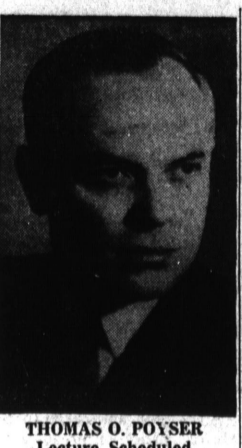
Lecturer To Speak Tomorrow

New Budget Approved by Gas Company

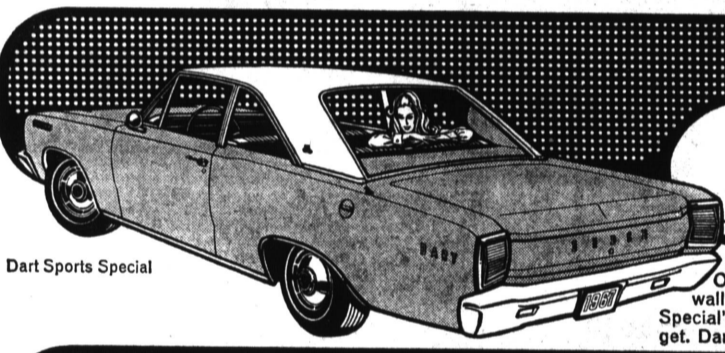

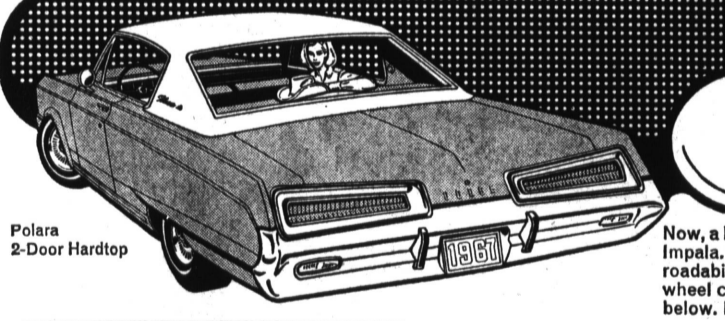
