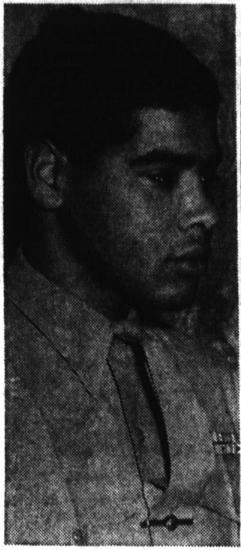
Telephone Hearings To Begin

To accommodate Southern Californians who plan to testify, the California Public Utilities Commission will shift public hearings on Pacific Telephone's application for a \$181 million statewide rate increase to Los Angeles today through Friday.

Proceedings on the application and the commission's own investigations into Pacific Telephone and the independent telephone companies were begun last Wednesday in San Francisco.

The Los Angeles hearings will begin at 10 a.m. in Room 115 of the State Building, 217 W. First St. Commission President Peter E. Mitchell and Commissioner William Symons Jr. will preside.

Today, Pacific Telephone's application will be reviewed and the statements of interested cities, counties, and organizations will be briefly repeated for the benefit of the public. Testimony from the company's customers and others will be taken. All interested parties may appear and be heard.

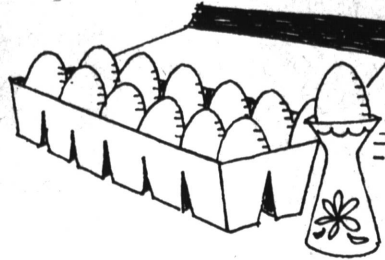

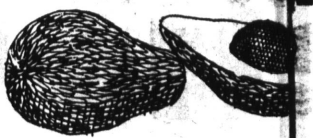
