"Recognition like this does not come easy," said Richardson, "and the Torrance Social Security employees had to compile an outstanding record to earn it. But when the

facts were all in we knew they deserved it."

Under the supervision of Miles Davis, district manager, the office at 1408 Crenshaw Blvd., was cited for its production, speed, and accuracy in providing superior public service, especially from July 1964 to July 1965, during which time it was also honored as "District Office of the Year."

Pointing to a production record including over 66,000

interviews with the public and 5,771 social security applications taken by the 21-man staff during that period, Richardson said, "Miles Davis and his staff showed that efficient and accurate service can be provided the public without sacrificing the quality of work needed where helping people is involved."

"The citizens of Torrance can take pride in their local Social Security office," Richardson added.

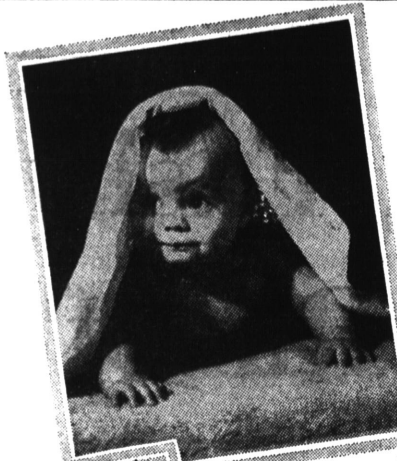
'Round-up Day' Event Scheduled
