

Just about the same as at home. Most things are brought in by ship — and that adds to the cost. We

that adds to the cost. We bought cube sugar yester-day — 22 cents more for a box than we pay at home.

On the plus side, you need little clothing. I pack three pairs of khaki shorts.

Two pairs of slacks. Five shorts deep side. short-sleeve shirts. One pair of sandals. I have a tropic weight suit and shoes for the occasional evening in Honolulu. But only a few places there require tie and lacket at night
