SACRAMENTO - Los An geles county's share of highway user tax distribution during June was \$3,103,930, State Controller Houston I. Flournoy announced today.

Total distribution for the state was \$127,923,609. Of this amount, \$107,565,534 went to the state highway fund for expenditure on state highways; \$9,758,664 directly to the counties: \$6,-245,545 went to the state highway fund for use on the select system of county roads and city streets; and \$4,353,went to the state highway fund for cities.

Flournoy announced that the total revenues were derived from the following sources: gasoline tax, \$42,036,-846; diesel fuel tax, \$2,802,651; and transfer from the motor vehicle transportation tax fund \$81,766,413.
