

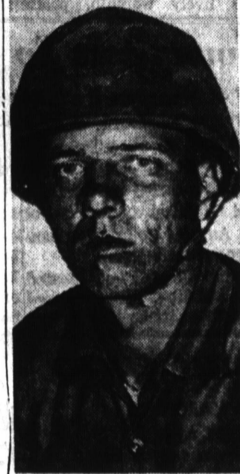
# ARMED FORCES
