"A ladies tournament would be a welcome addition for the golfing galleries of the greater Los Angeles area,

Houser said for some years the Los Angeles Junior Chamber of Commerce had been discussing the possibility of conducting a Ladies L. A. Open, and attempting to build a great tournament as the organization had done for the L. A. Open over the past 42 years.

"The ladies of the LPGA tour have always wanted to play in the Los Angeles area," said Wirtz, "and we are looking forward to putting on a great golfing exhibition and tournament." He added there are more women golfers in Southern California than in any other section
