How To Place Calls To A ZENITH Number

Before placing a call to a Zenith number, please refer to the directory listing of the subscriber desired and note the exchange or exchanges from which the particular Zenith number may be called. If the telephone from which you are calling is served from an exchange shown in the listing, proceed as follows:

Call Operator as you would for any other local number and ask for "ZENITH (number)."

MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES

TIME SERVICE

The time may be obtained from the operator upon request.

The charge for this service will be the same as the charge at your regular rate for any other local call.

TELEGRAMS BY TELEPHONE

To facilitate sending telegrams, cablegrams, or radiograms, please call telegraph companies as listed in this directory.

Charges for "Pacific Telegrams" at all exchanges and for telegraph messages of the Postal Telegraph Company and the Western Union Telegraph Company at certain exchanges, placed by telephone will be billed by the Telephone Company on its bill for service, or if sent from a public coin box telephone, the charges will be collected at the time the message is sent.

TELETYPEWRITER SERVICE

Subscribers to this service in any city can typewrite by wire instantly to each other at any time.

The service provides two-way communication with a speed of connection comparable with telephone service. With a short training period, a teletypewriter may be operated by any one who can operate a typewriter.

Further information may be obtained from the Business Office.

PRIVATE BRANCH EXCHANGE OPERATION

A representative of our Private Branch Exchange Department calls periodically at your premises to confer with you and your operator regarding the operation of the equipment that the best results may be received by you through your switchboard. She is able to outline for you the best telephone practices to be followed by your operator.

The assistance of this instructor may be obtained by calling the Chief Operator.

CONFERENCE TELEPHONE SERVICE

A number of individuals in different cities can be brought together by telephone for simultaneous discussion. To place a conference call or to secure rate or other information regarding this service, call Long Distance and ask for the Conference Operator.

INTEREXCHANGE RECEIVING SERVICE (ZENITH SERVICE)

This service is provided for the convenience of business subscribers who have customers in other cities. The business subscriber concerned may arrange to be listed in the directories of the cities or towns selected by him. A telephone number, such as "Zenith 1000," is assigned in the selected exchange and toll messages from that exchange completed to the Zenith number are billed to the subscriber to the interexchange receiving service at the Station-to-Station rate.

Customers using telephone stations served from the exchange in which the business subscriber has arranged for a Zenith number may call that number and be connected with the telephone designated for receiving the calls placed to that Zenith number.

EQUIPMENT FOR PERSONS WITH IMPAIRED HEARING

Equipment permitting amplification of the voice as heard in the receiver, is available for home or office use of telephone customers having impaired hearing. Further information may be obtained from the Business Office.

COASTAL AND HARBOR RADIOTELEPHONE SERVICE

This service is a two-way telephonic communication service, available 24 hours daily, between any telephone on land and watercraft, such as a harbor tug, pilot boat, fire boat, fishing boat, coast-wise ship, or yacht, which is suitably equipped for radiotelephony and within range of the land radiotelephone station. Information regarding the classes of Coastal and Harbor services rendered and the rates applicable thereto may be obtained from the Business Office.

To place a call from a land telephone to a radiotelephone station on board a harbor craft ask Long Distance for the Marine Operator.
