The regular meeting of the Torrance chamber of commerce was held Monday evening at 8 o'clock, with President E. Andem presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were read and accepted. Reports of committees were called for, and several responded, the committee out on signs not being present the matter was continued, with a new "sign" committee being "apointed, composed of the following: Geo. Proctor, L. F. Bennett and J. Isenstein. They were authorized to get the signs in place at once.

The Auditorium committee reported that arrangements had been made whereby the building will be completed within a very short time, and that the Theatre is leased for a term of five years, tenant to take possession as soon as completed. Also, one of the stores is leased at a good rental.

Postmaster Goudier reported that the amount of stamps sold the past month amounted to \$559.39 and \$347.18 stamped envelopes were ordered. This shows a most satisfactory increase over the previous month.

The committee on securing a meeting place recommended that the chamber take the hall in the Steffen building and it was endorsed by a vote of those present. The next meeting will be held in these new quarters.

There being but one more meeting of the chamber this year, in accordance with the by-laws, the officers for the coming year were nominated.

E. X. Andem was nominated for president; P. G. Briney, vice-presi dent; A. H. Bartlett, recording sec-retary; Postmaster Goudier, corre-sponding secretary. There being no further nominations the meeting was adjourned, so that the members could attend a meeting in Lomita where they were informed a meet ing was being held in favor of the Japs, but upon arriving there they found that it was a mistake and no such meeting was held. How-ever, the members called at the office of the News Letter and saw a modern printing plant—one that would do credit to a good sized city.
