### TORRANCE OFFERS BEST SITE

After interviewing different people all over Southern California for the better part of eighteen months, H. H. C. Hammerton of the Hammerton Co-operative Industries, stated yesterday that he was attracted to Torrance by virtue of the fact that here he found an abundance of the three principal requisites for his plan, namely: Economical Fuel, Water and Power Electricity. The cost of the land for his industries was a secondary consideration, provided the three above named principals were at hand.

The next best offer made him came from San Fernando, the site offered there being very desirable but some other features were not so favorable to a co-operative business plan as formulated by Mr. Hammerton.

While the promoter realizes that there is a shortage of commercial gas in Torrance to carry on a manufacturing business of the magnitude which he contemplates, yet, in previous experiences he has been confronted with this same problem, and to quote him, "Over \$160,000 was expended in one of his former enterprises in Pittsburg in producing economical fuel," and the gas problem or electrical power situation is dismissed by him by a wave of the hand.

A great many people who have heard of the co-operative industries thought at first such a plan was not practical, yet they were surprised to learn that nearly \$70,000 worth of lots had been disposed of. This means that several hundred people are all interested in one enterprise, and "co-operation" is being consistently preached to them, until they are all concentrated on the one plan. "Hammering" at one particular object, usually brings results.
