PREDICT SHORTAGE COMING

A prominent distributor of automobiles who recently returned from an extensive trip throughout the manufacturing districts in the east says that a real shortage in automobiles is coming and that the spring months will see the demand far ahead of the supply, and believes that the saturation point will never be reached in this country.

SIGNS ARE UP

On November 15 the National Old Trails highway from Kansas City to Los Angeles will be completely resignposted.

COMPLETE AUDITORIUM

To those interested in the Torrance Auditorium Theatre building, a statement of interest to stockholders was made at the last chamber of commerce meeting when it was announced that the new building had been leased for a period of five years on the following conditions:

The theatre has been leased for a period of five years at a good rental \$150 per month, is to be paid for the first six months, \$200 per month for the next 18 months, and \$300 per month for the remainder of the term.

One of the two store rooms has been leased for three years at a rate of \$50 per month the first year, \$60 per month the second year, and \$75 per month the third year.

ANXIOUS TO LEASE

Within three years from December 14 next, at latest, thousands of American truck gardeners and ranchers will immediately take over and operate the vast area of agricultural land in California from which the Japanese will be ousted under the provisions of the alien land law approved last Tuesday week by an overwhelming majority of the voters of the State.

In Los Angeles county alone 42,911 acres are now under lease to Japanese. All leases must lapse within three years after the time the law goes into effect, and this provision is resulting in a great rush to renew leases for the maximum period before the law becomes operative.

HOW ABOUT IT?

A survey in New York, according to the World, shows that the decrease in wholesale prices of men's clothing, ready-made, will probably be 40 per cent within the next six weeks and that tailor-made clothing should take a similar drop as the mills have reduced prices 33-1/3 per cent for a starter. One of the greatest Fifth-avenue merchants is reported as saying that the tendency is so rapidly downward that he dare not leave his desk for a minute lest he lose track of the market. "The public will not buy at present prices," he says, "and the merchants are finding they cannot move goods except by drastic reduction. We are going to get back very rapidly to pre-war prices."

COTTON CROP POOR

A. W.
