Scouts everywhere are interested in gardening and forestry. In a recent issue of Boys' Life, the chief scout executive reminds the boys of the movement that there is another kind of planting going on all the time, whether they are conscious of the process or not, Mr. West says:

Learn to do it, not 'any old way,' but just right, so that if the time comes when you are called upon, in the flash of an instant to put that knowledge to practical use, you will not be found wanting.

"Be prepared. Sow habits of energy, patience, perseverance. Train your mind and body to work together your mind and body to work together in splendid alliance. Live clean lives, think clean thoughts, read great books, follow true heroes; like Abraham Lin-reln and Theodore Roosevelt, Plant for tomorrow and manhood."
