The point moves haif a minute at a jump and travels more than half a mile in its 34 marathons around the dail dails of The dial is over 40 feet in diameter and illuminated at night—42 electric bulbs being used on the minute hand alone. minated at night—42 electric bulbs being used on the minute hand alone. The numbers on the dial are 5½ feet high. The pendulum rod is eight feet long, weighs 76 pounds, made of zinc and steel so proportioned as temperatif of accurate compensation and adjustment to overcome sudden and decided changes of temperature. The bob weighs 330 pounds. The weights which propel the hands weight which propel the hands weight 1,500 pounds and provide ample power to offset all wind resistance.
