



If you want to buy a "gat" you must ask Chief Anderson for a per-mit to buy one. Then you must buy it at a store that has taken out a license to sell them. And then you must secure a license to carry it. That's the new state law that went into effect August 17. Chief Anderson has been instructed to or-der license blanks. No person, un-der the law, will be able legiti-mately to purchase a pistol or re-volver without a permit to do so, and this permit will not be granted until 24 hours after application is made.
