GARNER APARTMENTS ARE COMPLETED

The completion of the Garner Apartments on Redondo boulevard gives to Torrance one of the most modern apartment houses in this locality. The building was designed and built by the Breuer Construction company for J. Cloyd Garner of this city at an approximate cost of \$10,000. Each apartment has its private entrances and halls, and consists of a living room and dining room each 14 feet square, with built-in bookcases, writing desk and buffet; a large bed closet with built-in dresser and mirror and a de luxe truck bed. These rooms, together with the entrance hall, have hardwood floors; a sunny bedroom has two exposures. The kitchen is complete with all modern conveniences and built-in features, including breakfast table. The bath room has all modern appointments, with woodstone floor and built-in bath-tub. Each apartment has two laundry trays on the rear porch, and a Thermo-storage heater gives a continuous supply of hot water to each apartment.

The upper apartments are equipped with speaking tubes and electric door openers, thus saving unnecessary trips down the stairs. The building, facing the south, gives every room the advantage of getting the sunlight at some time during the day.

Mr. Garner plans to beautify the grounds with terraced lawns, rose gardens, shrubbery, etc.

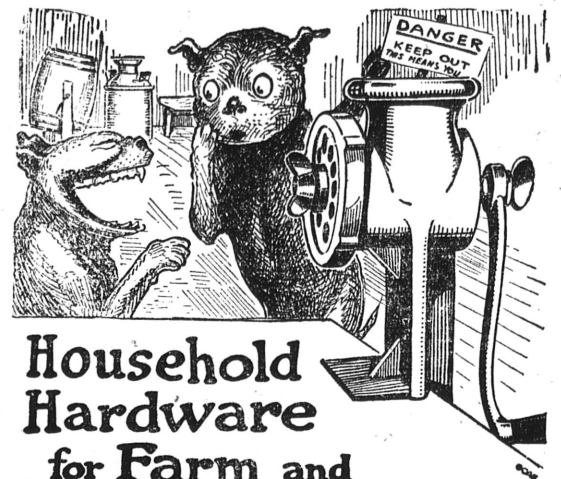
