Liberty is the unrestrained enjoyment of natural rights. The natural rights of the American citizen, as outlined in the Declaration of Independence, are plain and explicit. No restrictions are placed upon the citizen under the constitud the pursuit obedience to the law. The right to life, labor, are the fundamentals upon which the republic was built.
From time to time, since the Constitution was adopted and the Republic began to function, amendments have been added to the original document, and not the least valuable of these has been the Eighteenth, making illegal throughout the Continental United States and its insular possessions.
The right of the United States Congress to amend the Constitution has never been questioned.
