Sixth day: If the day is fine let chicks out in the yard for a short time and if possible see that they are out on the ground not later than end of the first week.

Do not allow chick mash after 2 p. m. until the birds are two months old. As a rule, it is best to have the mash well consumed by 1:30 so that the chick feed may be supplied for the last feeding of the day.

If the temperature is right the chicks should spread out over the floor of the brooder when sleeping. Be sure that they do not huddle in the corners.

Seventh day: Feed about as follows: 7 o'clock a. m., chick feed; 9 a. m., chick mash with buttermilk; 11 a. m., chick feed; 1 p. m., chick nash with buttermilk; 3:30 p. m., chick feed, Ordinarily the chick should eat about two-fifths buttermilk chick mash to three-fifths commercial chick feed.

As chicks are specially fond of some mashes they are apt to consume too great an amount unless it contains the proper amount of finely ground crude tiber, If you are feeding a concentrated chick mash, much care and attention must be given to the feeding and over-feeding must be guarded against. Place the mash troughs up on brackets out of reach of the chicks not later than 2 p. m. so they will have room for a grain feed as their last feeding.
