uting approximately one-half. Th fields of this state produced 710,00 barrels a day during the week jus quoted. The mid-continent also showed an increase previous week with Oklahoma producing 493,000 barrels daily increase of 11.700 barrels. The production for the entire try is given as over two mil-barrels daily.
