Extension Course With Wide Scope Possible In Torrance

Torrance will probably have University of California classes given in this locality before another year has passed. Instruction in the many interesting courses offered by the state university are now given in 81 California cities, and in the past year extension classes have been increased 33 per cent. More than 75,000 people throughout the state are now taking courses out of business hours. Any subject offered by the university will be given in Torrance if a sufficiently large class is organized. Information about the organization of such classes will be given if applicants address the University of California, 815 South Hill street, Los Angeles.

Following are some of the interesting courses offered by the university: Accounting, salesmanship, radio, the telephone, electrical meter testing, scenario writing, short story writing, French, German, Spanish, elementary economics, business and protective law for women, gasoline automobile, commercial law, advertising, money and banking, training of the speaking voice, public speaking, petroleum field technology, engineering mechanics; 19th century prose, Shakespeare, the Renaissance, and other culture courses of value to club women. Many other courses, too numerous to mention in detail, are offered by the university. These classes are not only designed for younger students, but have been particularly prepared for business people who wish to take up a course of study during evening hours.
