For those of my readers who do neir own house decorating I pass on the words of one who claims to have had a good deal of experience in such matters. First, he says, never try to tint a room till all cracks are filled with plaster of Paris paste, which is best to color with some of the waltint. Otherwise the newly tinted wall will show the former cracks, probably entphasized, if the new tint is darked enrphasized, if the new tint is darker than the old. Second, all water stains on plaster should be painted or enamicled at least one coat, better two, and allowed to dry thoroughly before beginning to tint. It is impossible to cover a water stain with cold water tint, no matter how many coats are applied. Third, a small quantity of glue, melted and thoroughly mixed with the tint, acts as a size and prevents the walls from appearing streaked when dry. But with this glue size added, one coat is usually sufficient and it will be smooth, without clouds or streaks.

Jellied Prunes.—Take one-third cup prunes, two cups cold water, boiling water, one-half cup cold water, one-half box gelatin or two and one-half tablespoons granulated gelatin, one cup sugar, one-quarter cup lemon Juice. Pick over, wash and soak prunes for several hours in two cups of cold water, and cook in same water until soft; remove prunes, stone and cut in quarters. To prune water add enough boiling water to make two cups. Coak gelatin in one-half cups. Coak gelatin in one-half cold water, dissolve in hot liquid sugar, lemon juice, then strain prunes, mold and chill. Sti add prunes, mold and chill. Sti-twice while cooling to prevent prune: from settling. Serve with sugar and

The dust bag of an electric cleaner should be emptied each time the cleaner is used. These bags are purposely made large to provide a large air filtering capacity instead of to provide a place for storing dirt. If the bag is full the machine cannot function as it should. The bag, should not be turned inside out to brush it or to wash it, because some bags are chemically treated to make them dustproof.

The easiest plan for mating socks and stockings is to mark each pair correspondingly. Use contrasting colored thread and make a cross-stitch mark on one pair of stockings, two cross-stitches for another, three and four for others. Straight stitches are also quickly done. These stitches in time save much trouble later.

When blankets, either cotton or woolen, become thin and threadbare they make a fine interlining for comforters. When pieces are used, lap the edges and baste to gether so that the edges will not curl up inside. Cover, line and knot the same as any other comforcer. Old worsted skirts can be used in the same way. Rip the skirt, reverse every other gore, lap the edges and baste together. Silkatene is very good for tying off with, as it passes through the material more easily than yarn. When blankets, either cotton or
