It is not possible to be a wise buyer of things with which you are not familiar. If you buy as much as possible by personal inspection, and in frequenting the markets care-fully observe the appearance of goods, you will scon learn just what good meat, fish, fruit and vegetables look like if they are really good. You will learn that the very white asparayus that comes first in the spring is very tough; that a young chicken has a tende breast-bone; that sprouting vegetables of any kind have lost much of their flavor, and that bulging cans usually mean spoiled cen-tents. By Dr. W. F. Thon Pickling is inexpensive if there is a kitchen garden to draw upon. An important con-sideration is the storage room available. Both pickles and reliahes must be kapt in a place which is cool but not freezing, dry, and light enough to see that things are in good condi-tion. Wooden spatulas are best to stir all cooked pickle mix-tures with, and bottles or jars should be filled over a common tray, as mustard and spiced stuff stain and discolor oil-cloth or fine table-tops. If the housewife feels that soap is necessary, use a mild soap. Linoleum may be waxed as a floor is waxed, the finished re-sult giving great satisfaction, as this waxing fills up the pores of linoleum, causing it to resist soil. Home-made pickles and rel-ishes are always a treat if they are well made and properly stored for winter use. Wide-mouthed bottles with tight corks are excellent to use for relishes, and small preserve jars for the pickles that cannot be stored in crocks. All bottled stuff must be sealed.
