It shall also be the duty of the City Marshal to proceed to collect any delinquent license fee, by order of the Board of Trustees, and to collect same in his discretion, by suit or otherwise.

SECTION 8. The conviction and punishment of any person for transacting any business, trade, calling, profession or occupation without license, shall not excuse or exempt such from the payment of a license fee due or unpaid at the time of such conviction and nothing contained herein shall prevent a criminal prosecution for any violation of the prayisions of this Ordinance.
