Strawberries and Pineapple in Sherbet Cups  
Chicken Patties Rolls  
Asparagus Tips on Toast

The strawberries should be washed and hulled and mixed with pineapple, either shredded or cut in small pieces. Either canned or fresh pineapple may be used, but I think I would prefer the fresh. Sweeten well and top with maraschino cherry. The patties you may buy if you have a reliable baker handy. If not, make a rich pie crust and bake over inverted gem pans. Fill with creamed chicken. Take a four-pound chicken, one can mushrooms, four sweetbreads, one quart cream, four tablespoons butter, five tablespoons flour, salt and pepper, nutmeg. Cook chicken until tender and take from bones, dice. Cook sweetbreads and dice also. Melt butter in

Rhubarb Conserv.—Take six pounds rhubarb cut in small pieces, one pound dried figs cut in strips or put through food chopper, add one-half pound English walnuts and five pounds sugar. Put the sugar over rhubarb, leave over night in the morning cook until thick, then add figs. Cook another 30 minutes, add walnuts coarsely chopped, and remove from fire. Put into jelly glasses. When cold, cover with paraffin. Store in a cool, dark place.

smooth, gradually adding the cream; stir until it thickens and season with salt, pepper and nutmeg. Then add chicken, sweetbreads and mushrooms, cutting the latter if large. Pour into patties and serve.

The Wedding Cake.—One and one-half cups shortening, three cups dark brown sugar, six eggs, one pound seeded raisins, one pound currants, one-half cup New Orleans molasses, one-half cup sour milk, one-half nutmeg grated, one tablespoon cinnamon, one teaspoon cloves, one teaspoon ground mace, one level teaspoon soda, four cups sifted flour.  
Stir the shortening and sugar to a cream, add the spices, the molasses and the sour milk. Mix well and then add the beaten yolks of the eggs. Stir thoroughly. Next add the flour alternately with the beaten whites of eggs. Lastly dissolve the soda in water and stir in thoroughly. Mix the fruit together and dredge it with flour, stir in the cake. Divide it into two parts and bake in moderate electric oven.
