

A very attractive bedroom can be made in the attic with but littl cost. Rhubarb Tarta,-Cut the rhubarb Into inch pieces without peeling it. The color is much pretier, and if the rhubarb is tender there is no ed for taking off the outside skin. Take four cups of rhubarb, one and one-hall cups of sugar, one tablespoon of cornstarch, and a very little water.
