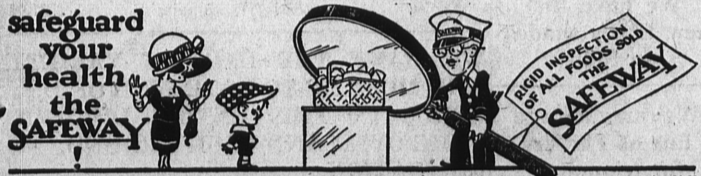

ORDINANCE No. 122

An Ordinance Fixing the Tax Rate for the Fiscal Year 1925-1926.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal tax upon all property in the City of Torrance to be collected for the fiscal year 1925-1926 as regular annual income for the City of Torrance is hereby fixed at \$96 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation of all taxable property in said City, and the rate of tax to be collected for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding bonded indebtedness of said City is hereby fixed at \$0.2 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation of said property.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, and thereupon and thereafter this ordinance shall be in full force and effect.
