

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION No. 260

MARTINA AVENUE

A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance, Declaring its Intention to Order the Improvement of Martina Avenue, Within Said City.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance, California, pursuant to the "Improvement Act of 1915," do resolve as follows: That MARTINA AVENUE, from the southerly line of 220th Street to the northeasterly line of Plaza del Amo, be graded and that the roadway space thereof be paved with six (6) inch Cement Concrete pavement, and that Cement Concrete curbs and walks be constructed thereon.

That all of the above described work or improvements be done at the places, to the extent and in the manner shown on the plans and detailed drawings therefor on file in the Office of the City Engineer and in accordance with specifications No. 24 for the construction of Cement Concrete Pavement and Ordinance No. 19 of the said City for the construction of Cement Concrete Curbs and walks on file in the Office of the City Clerk of said City.

All of which plans, detailed drawings and specifications are hereby referred to for a more particular description of said work or improvement, and by reference thereto are hereby made a part hereof.

The grade to which the said proposed work shall be done or said improvement made shall be such as is shown upon the said profiles therefor, and reference is hereby made thereto for a description of such grade.

SECTION 2. That the said proposed work or improvement in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, is of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and the costs and expenses of said proposed work or

improvement are hereby made chargeable upon a district which said district the said Board of Trustees hereby declares to be the district benefited by the said proposed work or improvement, and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof, which said district is bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the southerly line of 220th Street in said City, at a point thereon (135) one hundred thirty-five feet easterly of the easterly line of Martina Avenue, and running thence southerly parallel with the said westerly line of said Martina Avenue to the northeasterly line of Plaza del Amo, Thence northwesterly along the said northeasterly line of said Plaza del Amo to a point thereon one hundred thirty-five (135) feet at right angles westerly from the westerly line of said Martina Avenue, Thence northerly parallel with the said westerly line of Martina Avenue to the point of intersection with the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of 220th Street, thence easterly in a direct line to the point of beginning, excepting from the above all public streets, avenues, places or alleys included therein.

SECTION 3. Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments and bear interest at the rate of seven (7) per cent per annum, will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," the last installment of which bonds shall mature nine (9) years from the second day of July next succeeding ten (10) months from their date.

SECTION 4. Notice is hereby given that on Monday, the 23d day of November, 1925, at Seven o'clock P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of said City of Torrance, California, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement may appear before the said Board of Trustees and show cause why said proposed improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall cause this Resolution of Intention to be published twice in the Torrance Herald, a weekly newspaper published and circulated in said City and hereby designated for that purpose by the Board of Trustees of said City.

The Board of Trustees do not deem it advisable that the Clerk mail copies to the owners or reputed owners, and the City Clerk shall not mail copies of said notice.

SECTION 6. The Street Superintendent of said City is hereby directed to post Notices of Improvement as required by statute. Adopted and approved October 26th, 1925.
