


ORANGE BREAD

Here is an answer to the plea for "something different for afternoon tea":

Two cups tinely shredded orange peel, two cups water, two cups sugar, one cup milk, two tablespoons melted butter, one egg, three cups flour, two teaspoons baking powder, quarter teaspoon salt.

Cook orange peel in water for fifteen or twenty minutes until quite tender. Add sugar and cook for about thirty minutes until of the consistency of marmalade. Let cool a little, add melted butter, milk and egg mixed together, and the flour, baking powder and salt, which has been sifted together. Pour into buttered loaf pans, let stand for twenty-five minutes before baking. Bake one hour in a moderate oven—350 degrees.

Graham Bread.—Take one-quait

Graham Bread.—Take one-quarter cup of sugar, one-quarter of molasses, two cugs sour m Dissolve in milk one teaspoon baking soda and one teaspoon salt. Take two and one-half or graham flour and one cup white flour and one teaspoon baking powder. Mix and put i pans half hour before baking. B in a moderate oven.

Peppers Stuffed with Rice.—Cook one cup of rice until tender in one quart of well seasoned white stock. Met one-quarter cup of butter, add two tablespoons of chopped red pepper and four tablespoons of chopped contons, and cook two minutes; then add four tablespoons of chopped mushrooms and cook until tender. Add the prepared rice and mix thoroughly. Cut the tops from eight green peppers, remove the seeds and partitions, cover with boiling water and let stand five minutes. Drain, fill with the rice mixture, cover with buttered crumbs, arrange in a baking dish and bake one-half hour. Tomatoes may be used in place of mushrooms, if preferred.

Meat Loaf with Pickles—Five
pounds beef (ground), four cups
sifted crumbs, two cups milk, three
cups tomatoes, two cups chopped
celery, three eggs, one tablespoon
salt, two ounces chopped onlon,
eight to twelve sweet pickles. Add
the tomatoes, celery, salt, onlon
and crumbs to the meat and mix
well. Beat the eggs slightly, add
the milk and mix with the meat.
Cover the bottom of well greased
loaf pans with the mixture. Then
place a row of pickles end to end
in the pans. Fill in with the remainder of the meat mixture. In
order to have the loaves uniform,
be careful to press the meat well
into the corners of the pans and
avoid having the center higher than
the sides. This makes five and
three-quarters quarts of mixture
and weighs nine pounds when
haked. Bake in a moderate oven
until done. Allowing four ounces
for each serving, thirty-six may be
served from this amount.

When washing painted and varnished woodwork and walls, use a large sponge instead of a cloth, or a number of them, as is necessary in housecleaning. The sponge gets into corners more easily than a cloth. It does not leave spots on walls and woodwork that a cloth will do if not dry, but leaves a bright finish. You can do the same amount of cleaning walls in half the time as by the rag method. by suitable means before the article is wet, as scapy water sets stains. Scap or scap powder is much more efficient when dissolved in very hot water, as all the scap is then contained in the solution, and it will be much more effective in softening and removing dirt and grime.

Tarts.—Shells for tarts may be made of plain pastry, rolled thin and fitted over the backs of small muffin pans for baking, or baked as patty shells inside the tins. When ready to serve, fill with cooked fruit filling: Serve with soft custard, Devonshire cream, whipped cream, or fruit sauce. Another way of making tarts is of fill unbaked shells (fitted into small tart tins) with uncooked fruit and bake for fifteen minutes in hot oven. Cover with sweetned meringue and return to oven just long enough to brown.

Biotting paper placed between fine china plates when it is necessary to pile them together will be found useful. Cut the paper in circles large enough to cover the inside of the plates.
