Cocoanut Cream Pie.—Line a pie tin with rich pie crust and bake. Fill with following custard: Two eggs, two cups milk, three table-spoons sugar, two tablespoons cornstarch, one teaspoon flavoring. Put milk in double boiler and heat. Beat yolks of eggs well, add sugar, stir well, then add to hot milk. Dissolve constarch in cold milk and pour slowly into hot mixture sitring well to avoid lumps. After it has cooled remove from fire and add flavoring. Vanilia with just a little almond extract gives a delicious flavor. Beat whites of eggs stiff, add two tablespoons sugar, then drop on pie (don't spread smooth). Sprinkle with shredded ecocanut and brown in moderate oven. Do not brown in moderate oven.


When you wish to hem table linen, first run it through the sewing machine hemmer without any thread in the needle. You will then have a neat, even hem turned, ready for sewing.
