Curried Cauliflower.—Boil a firm white head of cauliflower in salted water; when tender, drain and pour over it the following: Melt two tablespoonfuls of chopped onlon, two teaspoonfuls of chopped onlon, two teaspoonfuls of ground one of curry powder, a teaspoonful of chopped apple; cook all together, then add one cupful each of water and milk with salt to season, pour over the cauliflower, and serve at once.

Cottage Chesse Soun.—Take a once.

Cottage Cheese Soup.—Take a pint of milk, a tablespoonful of butter, the same of flour, cooked together; half a teaspoonful of salt, pepper to taste, and a half cupful of cheese. Add onlon juice to season, if liked. Melt the butter, add flour, and cook, then add the milk and cheese.
