INVITING DISHES

For those who cannot eat meat often a main dish is a problem which needs thought, as it must contain nourishment and at the same time be attractive enough to appeal to the taste.

Carrots With Rics.—Scrape and cut into thin silices a dozen small

crumbs, and bake until the crumbs are brown.

Noodles With Peppers—Those who like the flavor of the green pepper will enjoy this dish: Cook aufficient noodles to serve the family; when tender drain and add a small can of pimentoes, the canned red peppers, add a cupful of stock or gravy, salt and pepper and a tablespoonful of butter. Simmer together for ten minutes and serve hot.

Spanish Rice.—Chop one small onion fine, add one chopped green pepper, and cook ten minutes in two tablespoonfuls of oil. Add four siliced tomatoes and one-half cupful of hot water. Cook to the boiling point, then add a cupful of rice. Cook slowly one hour, adding more water, if needed to keep it moist. The rice should be previously cooked before adding to this dish.
