45 Tons of Cocoanuts At Terminal Island For Safeway Stores

Forty-five tons of fresh cocoa-nuts, consigned to the Safeway stores of Los Angeles, have ar-rived at Terminal Island from Colon, Panama, on the S. S. Alaska, of the Compagnie Generale Trans-tilantique. The shipment, totaling nearly 55,000 nuts, is the largest ever made to the Pacific coast, eccording to Edward Dale, Safe-way's vice-president and general nnaager.

"This is the first time that cocoanuts have ever been featured
here in the retail market," Mr.
Dale says. "But we wanted to do
something different for a change,

"That was two months ago. Antonio Gutzner and William H.
Campbell, two young importers and
exporters of Los Angeles, who were
familiar with trading conditions in
Panama, were called in and told
what we were looking for. Nuts
with a circumference of 14 inches

runs from eight to eleven inches.
Gutzner tells me that some of the
nuts he obtained show a girth of
20 inches, twice the regular size!

The two boys left the following day for Colon, where they chartered a tramp steamer and cruised down along the San Blas coast. For a distance of 200 miles they traversed the eastern shoreline of Panama, and when finally they reached the end of the cocoanut belt they had let our orders for a total of nearly two hundred thousand nuts, four times what their contract with Safeway specified!

"But the boys knew what they were doing. Instead of relying upon the natives to furnish them with only the larger nuts, they bought them up in dug-out lots irrespective of size. All the way back to Colon the natives swarmed about the sides of the steamer, transferring their 'catches' to its decks, where Gutzner and Campbell occupied themselves with the tedious job of sorting out the better and larger nuts for consignment to Los Angeles. After the steamer had berthed at Colon three weeks were spent in disposing of the 150,000 standard-sized nuts to local merchants. Then the Safeway cargo, consisting of hand-picked nuts of large size, was loaded onto the Alaska, the voyage to Los Angeles consuming 12 days."

Airplanes Will Do **Much To Eliminate** City Smoke Clouds
