
## Dodge Introduces America's "Fastest Fours"

Washington, D. C., Aug. 4, 1927—

The Department of Commerce announces that, according to the returns received, there were 55,684 marriages performed in California luring the year 1926, as compared with 55,080 in 1925, representing an increase of 1,584, or 2.9 percent.

During the year 1926 there were 12,065 divorces granted in the state, as compared with 10,624 in 1925, expresenting an increase of 1,441 or 13.6 per cent. The number of ilvorces granted in 1924, however, was 11,258 or considerably more chan the number reported for 1925.

There were 1,281 marriages annulation in 1926, which marriages annulation have been reported.

The estimated population of the state of California on July 1, 1926, was 4,316,000, and on July 1, 1925, 1,180,000. 
