STUCCO NEEDS oncret

Stucco, like wood and metal, needs paint-ing for protection. It is constantly attacked by carbonic acid in the atmosphere which causes gradual disintegration.

Unpainted stucco will also absorb moisture. After heavy rains, dampness may linger for weeks. This to gether with changing weather conditions and the resulting rapid changes in moisture content, may cause unsightly streaks and cracks.

For these reasons stucco should be painted, but on account of lime, which is in all stucco, a special lime-resisting paint is necessary. 

"Parents, wives and children of disabled veterans whose death such dependents feel confident was due to a disability either caused or agravated by military service, should not fail to file claim for dependency compensation.

"Any veteran of the World War, whether disabled or not, is entitled to an adjusted service certificate which is a form of insurance provided by the government. Any veterans in the district who have falled to file for this certificate should do so at once, because January 1, 1928 is the final date on which these claims will be accepted and also because falium by a veteran to file claim in his own lifetime reduces the award to his dependents by more than 50 percent.
