Vierling Kersey, assistant super-intendent of Los Angeles city schools, gave a very instructive talk at the first meeting of the Torrance Elementary Parent-Teach-er Association Tucsday afternoon. His subject was "What Shall I Ask Myself at the Beginning of the School Year? Should I Be Ah In-different Parent?"
