This is one of the most to good feeding and general care. complaint made of mal-nourished children. This is one of the most noticeable and, serious effects of under-nutrition. A child cannot grow a stable, well-developed nervous system on a faulfy-diet. Defects in diet are shown in nervous ness and irritability as convincingly as lack of weight or growth in height. Nerve debility may also be shown in slowness, excessive sleepiness and body exhaustion.

A child grows the first six years of life, a skull which reaches adult circumference and a brain of almost adult weight. With his rapid growth comes marked instability of the whole nervous system. The cessential food materials of a well commended diet must be given a child at all times for normal nerves to grow. Nerves become frayed from stimulation if they do not have their needed covering of fat.
