The car should be kept in the best possible condition so that it will respond to any emergency which might result from circumstances due to the wet season. The windshield wiper should be in the best of working order.

On streets and highways that are shaded by trees, the motorist should maintain great caution, as the leaves from the trees fall to the ground, and the moisture which adheres to them greatly increases the chances of skidding. The results are often serious.

The motorist should slow down when approaching such a road, and it is advisable to shift into low gear and proceed through the water slowly so that the engine will not be showered with water.

#### State Tells Motorists How to Adjust Headlights on Own Cars

SACRAMENTO—Instructions designed to teach every motorist in California to adjust his own lights so that they will comply with the law and not glare, were issued here down by George F. Moynahan, tecting chief inspector of the Division of Motor Vehicles.
