the city being 80 feet wide and extending from Dalton ave the city, being 00 feet wide and extending from Dalton ave
nue to the city limits. Three miles beyond Saugus a temporary bridge has been constructed over the santa Clara River to replace the one destroyed by recent flood watere Only plies of drifted sand denote the former location of

geles, the real climb over the Ridge commences. Wonder geles, the real cimb over tee mage con this section within

Mariposa thistles all add to the attractiveness of this very scenic canyon drive. Scarret trumpets, , blooming sypsum
