Another One-Day Trip

Another One-Day Trip. San Antonio Canyon is now a popular objective for one-dy motor trips. Leaving the Foothill boulevard at a point 4% miles beyond Claremont, pavement is traversed for five miles, thence a wide graded gravel road on which resurfac-dition of the stream in this point a fair to good wiles distant. For a Few Days **Camping and Fishing**

Camping and Fishing A pleasant trip through a very interesting section of the country is the one beginning at Los Angeles and taking one over the Ridge route through the San Joaquín Valley, to the North Fork of the Kaweah, 239 miles distant. At the junction of the rivers, one mile above Three Rivers, motorists should cross the bridge and continue up the North Fork for 10.8 miles to the location of an old fishing camp. Here machines may park and fisherman may begin trying their skill in the North Fork. The road up North Fork is narrow but can be easily driven by one accustomed to mountain driving. All along the main Kaweah River from Lemon Cove to Three Rivers are to be found some splendid camping places with shady trees and the big river right in front of your door. The trout in this section are all gamey and the varieties are: Rainbow, Steelhead and Loch Leven, all ranging from 8 to 14 inches in length.
