ORDINANCE NO. 182
REGULATING THE MOVING OF
BUILDINGS AND TANKS OVBRISTERETS, ALLEYS AND
PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY
OF TORRANCE.

An ordinance regulating the moving of buildings or tanks upon public highways and other public
places and prescribing regulations
under which permits shall be issued for the moving of buildings or
other structures thereon, within the
eity of Torrance and declaring the
violation of any of the provisions
of this ordinance to be a misdemeanor and prescribing, a punishment for such violation.

The City Council of the City of
Torrance does ordain as follows:
Section 1, It shall be unlawful
for any person, firm or corporation, to move, or to cause to be
moved, any tank more-than eight
feet (8') in diameter or any building or any section or portion of
any-building, over, upon, along or
across any nublic highway, road,
street, alley, or other public place,
without first obtaining a permit in
writing from the Street Superintendent or Building inspector so to
do, in the manner provided by this
ordinance.
