BREAD PUDDING DESSERT

1 package lemon junket, 1 pint milk, 1 slice bread, Butter, Raisins.

Remove crumbs from bread, but to lightly and cut in small cubes. Divide the cubed bread among dessert dishes and add a few seeded raisins. Warm the milk to lukewarm—not hot; add the lemon junket. Stir until dissolved; pour over bread. Let stand in a warm place until firm—then chill. Sprinkle with a mixture of sugar and cinnamon before serving.

A BALANCED MEAT DISH

Shred one pound of lamb, beef or pork and brown in its own fat in a frying pan. Add one cup of chopped celery and celery tops, one tablespoon minced onion and one tablespoon salt. Cover and cook about ten minutes. Add two tablespoons flour and two tablespoons butter mixed together and two cups canned, strained tomato juice.

Stir until the mixture is thick and bubbling, then serve.

GINGER SNAP SAUCE (For Tongue)

5 ginger snaps, 1/2 cup brown sugar, 4 tablespoons vinegar, 1 cup hot stock or water, 1 lemon, sliced, 1/2 cup raisins, 1/2 teaspoon onion juice. Combine all the ingredients and cook until smooth.

LUNCHEON DELIGHT

4 eggs, 1/2 cup grated cheese, 1/2 cup soft bread crumbs, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1 cup white sauce, 1 cup white sauce, Few grains cayenne. Break the eggs into a buttered baking dish and cook in hot oven until they begin to turn white around the edge. Then cover eggs with white sauce, and over this mixture of crumbs, cheese and cayenne. Brown in very hot oven so eggs will not be overcooked by the time cheese is brown.

AMBROSIA, SOUTHERN STYLE

1/2 lb. shredded coconut, 1 to 2 cups orange juice, 1 to 2 cups pineapple (optional), 2 bananas (optional). Cut sections of oranges into slices, three pieces, add sliced banana and sliced pineapple. Sprinkle with sweetened to taste. Add coconut and serve cold. Delightful with cream on the inside with just a little sugar. A pretty party treat and straw hat.

CARROT MARMALADE

1 cup carrots, 1 cup sugar, 1/2 cup lemon juice, 1/2 cup water, 1/2 cup vinegar, 1/2 cup raisins.

1 teaspoon ground allspice. Grate carrots, add sugar and let stand one hour. Add lemon juice and spices. Cook slowly for 1 hour. Turn into sterilized jars and seal when cold.

CREAMED CRAB MEAT

1 green pepper, 2 tablespoons butter, 2 tablespoons flour, 1/2 cup evaporated milk, 1/2 cup water, Fine bread crumbs, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 teaspoon pepper, 1 slice onion, minced, 1 teaspoon parsley, minced, 2 cups crab meat, flaked (fresh or canned).

Remove stems of peppers, cut in halves, lengthwise; remove seeds and packed in jars in boiling salted water and drain. Make a cream sauce of the butter, flour, milk diluted with water, and seasonings. Add the crab meat to the cream sauce. Arrange the pepper cases in a baking dish, fill with the crab mixture, cover the top with fine bread crumbs and dot with bits of butter. Bake in oven at 350 degrees for 20 minutes.
