Mechanical Man Talks Love, Device Scrambles and Unscrambles Code

"Mary, I love you," says a husky voice through an artificial larynx, working in connection with a man-made mechanical lung.

The wonders of these manufactured and almost human organs as well as new mysteries of modern electrical science, such as inverted and delayed speech, and a phonograph that plays a picture, were demonstrated a few days ago by Sergius P. Grace, while he visited Southern California.

More than two thousand engineers, specialists, and scientists in the Bell Laboratories are engaged in technical research that is solving the problems of speech transmission and radio broadcasting.

Speech into high frequencies and high into low frequencies. From the use of changed frequencies nearly one thousand new languages might be invented, according to Mr. Grace.

Delayed speech is a development brought about by experimentation for the improvement of trans-Atlantic service. Sounds going into the transmitter can be delayed or stored up for a three-second interval before being emitted.

The artificial larynx and the mechanical lung which Mr. Grace demonstrated are two purely human inventions of the Bell Laboratories. They enable those who have lost their voices by operation or accident to talk clearly and with a range of tone inflections.

Mr. Grace also demonstrated an electrical brain, and he played a record of a human heartbeat. He also presented a demonstration in defying the law of gravity with Cobalt steel, developed in the Bell Telephone Laboratories.

For thirty years, Mr. Grace has been connected with the Bell Laboratories. Their most noteworthy achievement during this time, he declared, has been the development of the modern telephone system and its present state of efficiency and adequacy.
