**Lomita Girl to Be Missionary**

Miss Melva Johnson, Member of Torrance Church, Latter Day Saints

Miss Melva Johnson, member of the Church of Jesus Christ, Latter Day Saints, of Torrance will leave Saturday, June 30, for Ogden, Utah, enroute to the Mission Home at Salt Lake City.

At the Mission Home, beginning July 3, Miss Johnson will take a two weeks' intensive course of training preparatory to two years as missionary. It is unusual for missionaries to be chosen from sections so far distant from the Mother Church. Miss Johnson is the second from this district, being preceded by Miss Mable Hakes of Wilmington, also well known in this community.

There are several features connected with missionary work of the Latter Day Saints or Mormons, as they are commonly termed, that differ from missionary departments of other churches.

The missionaries receive no training other than the doctrines of the church which are instilled from childhood, and the two weeks' course at the Mission Home. They must be physically fit, and must have accumulated sufficient means, or their family must be able to support them during their two years of service. They receive no salary, nor financial aid, whatever, from the church. All secular forms of amusement are taboo, as is social intercourse with members of the opposite sex.

Miss Johnson will stop in Ogden, for a visit with her grandfather, Art John Neutebaum, a prominent elder in the Ogden church. Elder Neutebaum has made two missions to his native country, Holland, and one to Arizona. He is well known to local Mormons through visits at the home of Miss Johnson's parents, Mr. and Mrs. H. L. Johnson, 2529 257th street.

The two weeks' training at the Mission Home includes lectures on such subjects as "What It Means to Be a Missionary," "How We Got the Bible and How to Use It," "Doctrines and Covenants," "Prophecies and Prophecies of the Old Testament," "The Gospel Standard Applied to Missionary Labors," "Fundamentals of the Gospel," "The Importance of Keeping One's Covenants," "Instructions in English, French, German and Spanish," public speaking and music; social demeanor; relief and primary work in the missionary field, and medical advice.

Headquarters of both Miss Hakes and Miss Johnson will be the Central States Mission Home at Independence, Missouri. During the two years, no visits home are allowed, although relatives may visit the missionaries. The lady missionaries, working in pairs, room together and are held to a strict daily regime.

Miss Johnson is a graduate of Lomita high school of the class of '25. For the past two years she has been full time clerk at the Lomita Elementary school, previous to 1927, dividing her time first with the school at Terminal and then with the Walteria school. She is the secretary of the Lomita Alumni association. She was born in Ogden, Utah, and came to California with her family in 1918, and for 7 years has resided at the 257th street address.

**Torrance Notes**

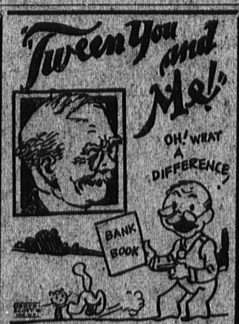

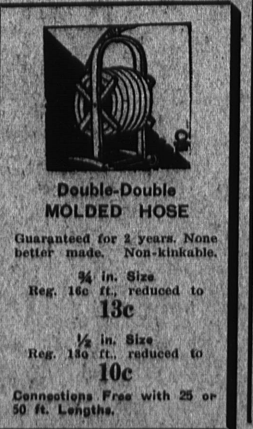
