PITTSBURG, Calif. — Finger prints left carelessly on an automobile more than a year ago, with probably link William H. Holden, wanted as a suspect in the attempted Columbia Steel payroll robbery from the Southern Pacific train near here, with a bank holdup in Colorado in which a bank president and his son were slain and two tallies kidnaped, according to an announcement made by Sheriff R. R. Veale.
