Only Three a Week to Allow Overhauling of Harvard and Yale

The fleet of LASSCO coastwise liners, Yale and Harvard, will in turn be sent to shipyards for their annual overhauling, inspection and complete overhaul of hulls and machinery during the period from January 20 to February 12 inclusive.

The Yale will be the first to go through the annual inspection and "shining up" process. The liner will arrive at San Diego Sunday evening, January 19, and will head back to Los Angeles upon discharge of cargo.

During the drydock interval, the LASSCO service will consist of three sailings weekly, instead of the usual four sailings, to and from each of the ports of Los Angeles and San Francisco.

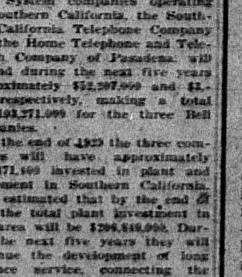

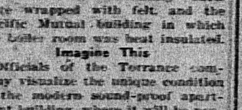

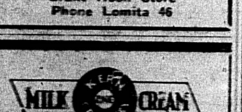
