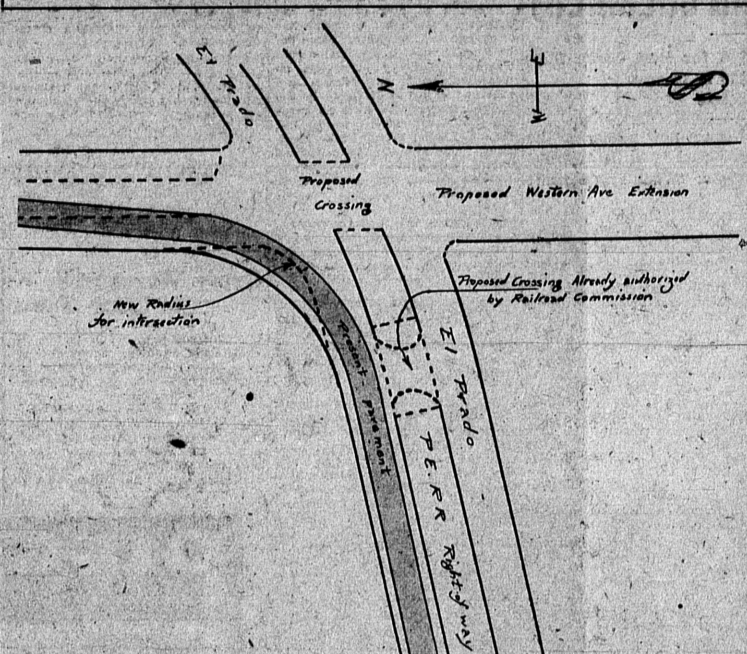

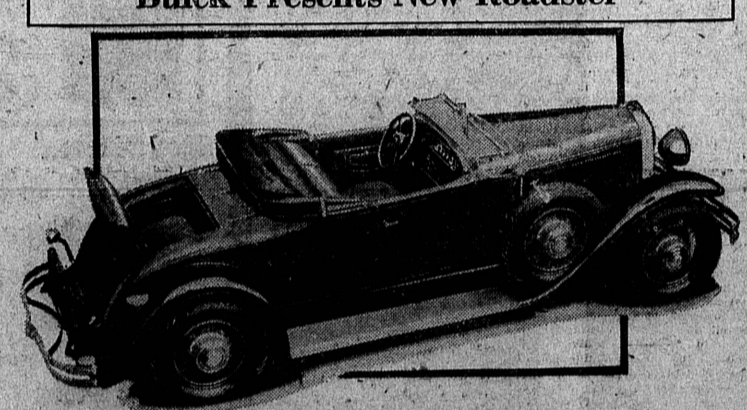
A Founders' Day program will be presented and a birthday cake will feature the serving of refreshments.
