THAT CAR OF YOURS

It is advisable to use white lead on new hose connections on your car to assure a water-tight fit. Never use shellac.

Difficulty in keeping brakes adjusted on your car may be caused by wheels, axle or brake drums being out of true.

When tightening the car, don't overlook the anchor bolts that hold the motor.

The carburetor on your car cannot be adjusted properly when the motor is cold.

A thin dime is a good gauge

for spark plug gap. If the gap is too wide the motor will be hard to start, and it will miss on quick acceleration. If too close, the motor will miss, or run unevenly at idling speed.

Steering mechanism, spindles, shackles, and brake assembly on your car should be lubricated offener in rainy weather. Continued splashing of water on these parts makes frequent greasings necessary.

Sometimes a spring shackle bolt on your car will develop a squeak that greases will not squeak that greases will not squeak. A suggested remedy is to give the bolt one-half turn, or to loosen out and drive bolt part way out and then drive back in place again.
