Taxes Are Involved In Proposed Amendment In Nov. 4 Election

Several amendments to the California Constitution are being considered in the election of November 4...

Among these is amendment 21, a proposition designed to reimburse the state for losses from state taxation. Many counties in California have in revenue what the state removed in 1911...

The amendments would reimburse those counties which have such revenue property of utilities within their borders, such as railroad yards, power plants, etc. The department of finance is instructed to report to the legislature every two years the loss sustained by such counties because of inability to tax the revenue property.

Another amendment is the one known as "the tax on land". It proposes that the state shall have the power to tax the land in California counties...

Amendment 22, known as the "railroad" amendment, proposes that the state shall have the power to take over any railroad which is not operated for the public interest...

Amendment 23, known as the "state income" amendment, proposes that the state shall have the power to tax the income of individuals...

Amendment 24, known as the "state debt" amendment, proposes that the state shall have the power to incur debt for the purpose of financing any public work...

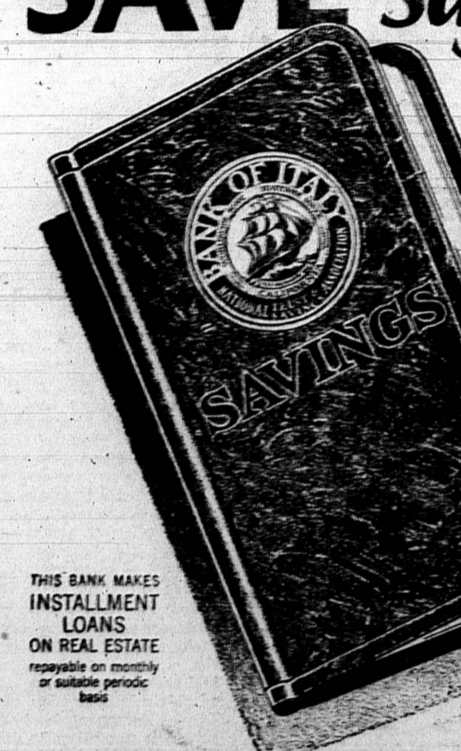
