

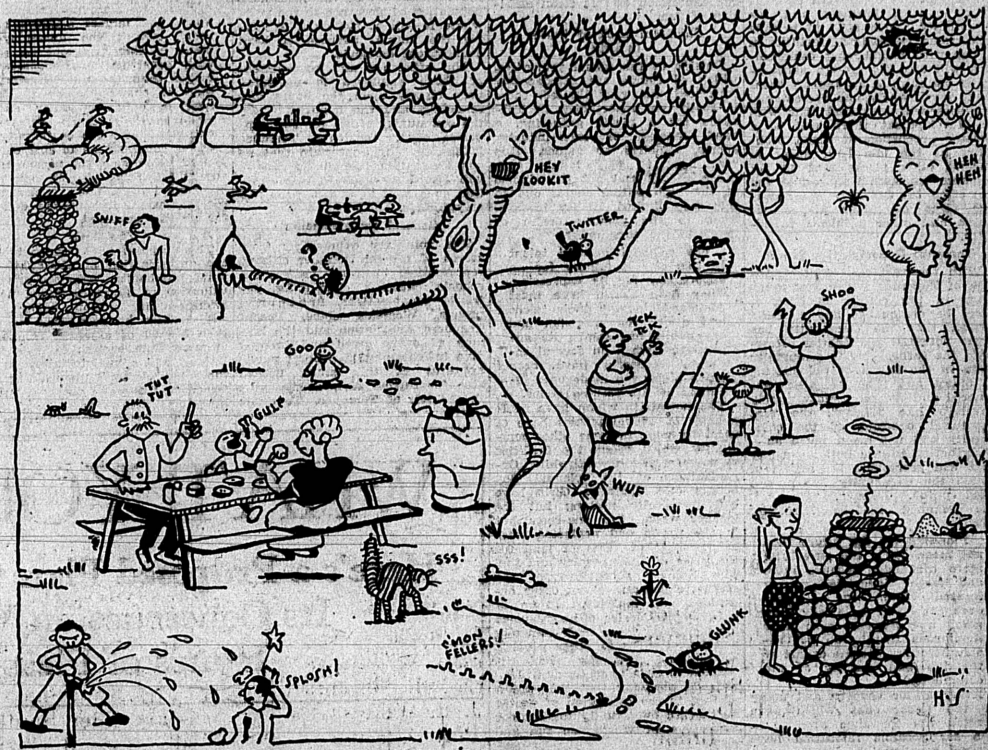

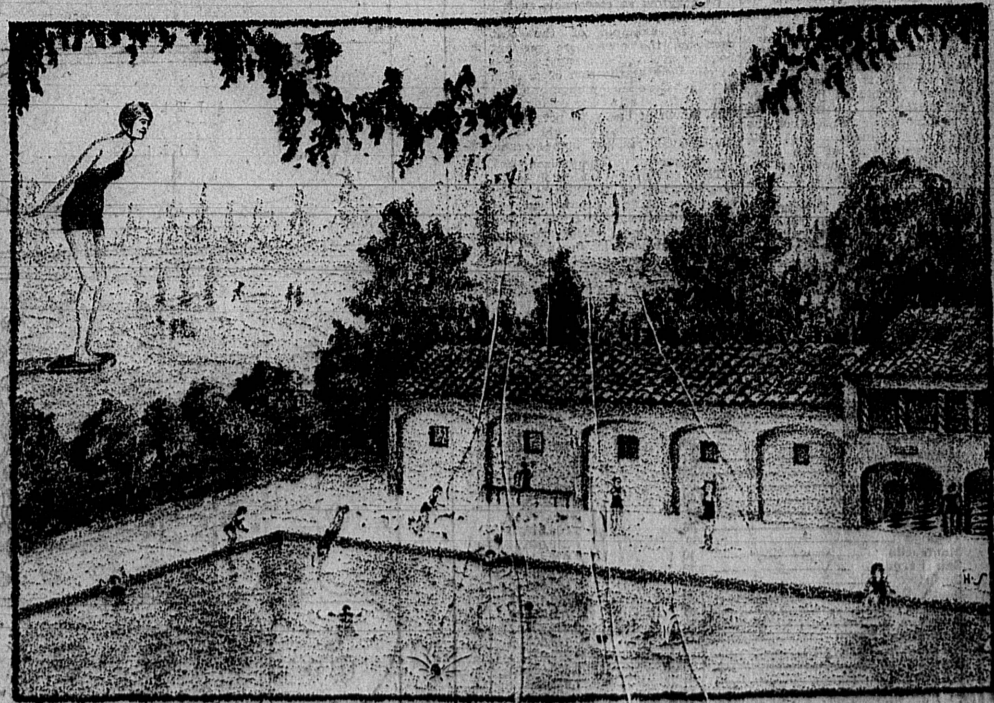

"A-picnicking We'll Go!"



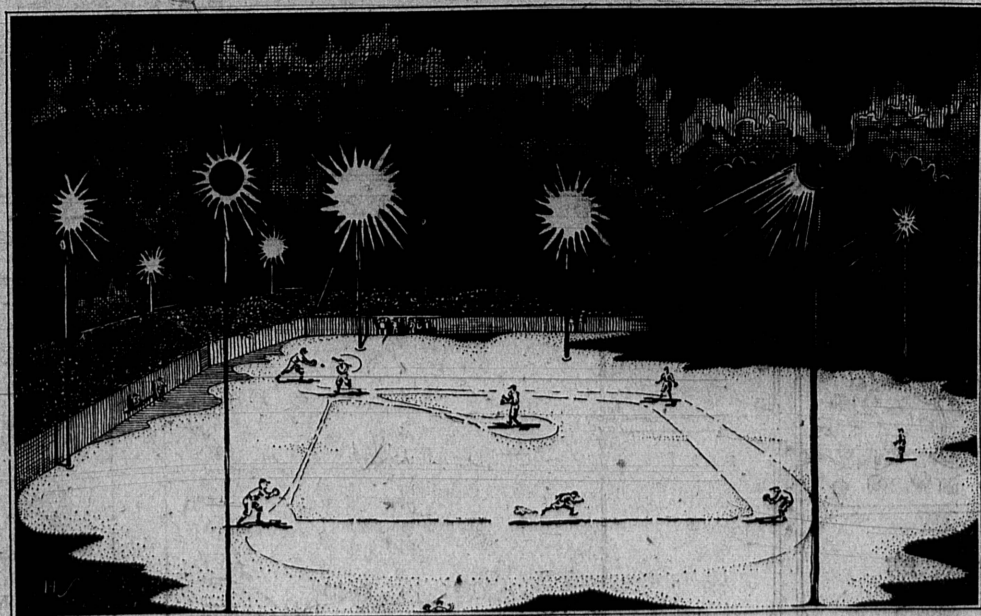
